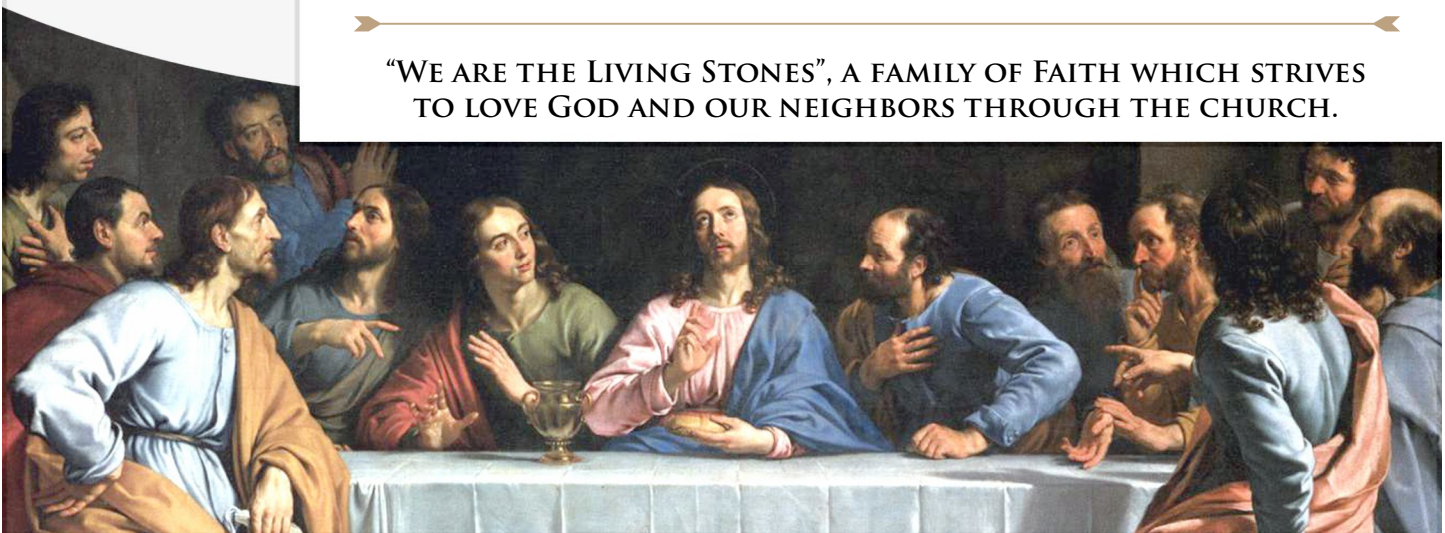

SUNDAY READINGS

HIS WORD TODAY—by Rev. William J. Reilly
Most Holy Name Catholic Church, Garfield, NJ

“Jesus said to the Jewish crowds: I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world... Jesus said to them, Amen, amen, I say to you unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life in you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day.”

The great gift of the Father was to send the Son. The great gift of the Son was to remain with us in the gift of His Body and Blood. What makes us who we are is that we are a Eucharistic people. We draw our life from Jesus present in the sacrament of His Body and Blood. How careful we must be to recognize this great gift, Jesus present to feed, Jesus present to receive my praise and adoration, Jesus present to unite myself and others in com-union.

There are many types and varieties of bread. There is rye and white bread, there is sourdough and raisin bread, there is French and Italian bread but there is only one Living Bread. Using the Old Testament expression, ‘I am’, Jesus tells us where we can find Him, in the Eucharist. ‘The Body of Christ’ ‘Amen.’

Today’s Readings

First Reading: Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14b-16a

Moses reminds the Israelites that when they were starving in the desert, the Lord fed them with “manna” -- a food not known to them.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 10:16-17

Paul points out to the Corinthians that through the sharing of the cup and the breaking of the bread, they are all one in Christ Jesus.

Gospel: John 6:51-58

After Jesus feeds the five thousand people with barley loaves and fishes, he tries to make them understand the significance and the meaning of what he has done. He tells them, in mysterious and beautiful words, that the bread he gives is his flesh and says, “I myself am the living bread... If anyone eats this bread, he shall live forever.”



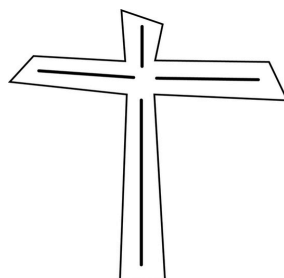

Appalachian Mission

St Bernard Appalachian Mission – UPDATE Save the date – July 11-18

To recap 2025, the St. Bernard's volunteers managed to complete the electrical, plumbing, and insulation for two new homes. We also funded the sheetrocking and painting for both homes. (By the way, this work was accomplished by a local who in turn was able to afford to insulate his own home.) As I reported previously, the first house was turned over to "Jessie" while we were there in October. "Pearle", shown below receiving the key to her new home, moved in on Nov 22nd. Pearle's trailer had been badly damaged by a falling tree in the early spring. They both were able to celebrate the holiday season in their new homes. All this made possible by the support and prayers of St Bernard parishioners. Imagine how many of Pearle's and Jessie's (on the left below) family members have been touched by what was accomplished and how many holidays will be celebrated in the new homes.

For 2026, we again are on track to build two new houses – as well as multiple repair jobs. There are two work camps, one in June where the first house will be built. We will be attending the second work camp from Saturday July 11 – July 18 working the electrical and plumbing on the first house – as well as assisting in the second house build. Quite an ambitious time – but the need continues. We will be returning in the fall (dates to follow) to complete the builds. I'll keep you posted on progress. Please consider volunteering. No experience necessary – only the passion to follow our Christian teaching of taking care of the less fortunate.

Thank you again for your support, your prayers and all you have contributed to this very worthwhile and important cause. Over the years, the hundreds of people that have been helped are truly appreciative of the love you have shown.

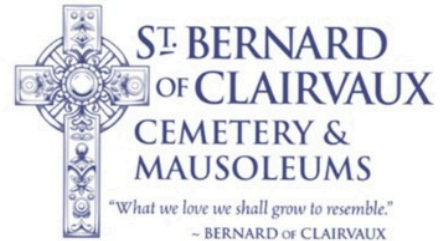
