From Rev. Michael's Desk

One of the readings for the vigil of Pentecost from the eleventh chapter of Genesis tells of how people wanted to build a tower to reach the sky and defy God. We know it as the tower of Babel. The people end up each speaking a different language and becoming separated, alienated from each other. At the descent of the Holy Spirit on the feast of the Pentecost, the reverse happens. People who speak different languages are able to understand the Apostles each in his own language. It's really a gift of understanding. King Charles in his recent visit quoted Oscar Wilde "We have really everything in common with America nowadays, except, of course, language."

It's getting in society harder and harder to communicate sometimes especially in the same language — the language of civility. To be kind to one another and to help each other. One great example in our great state is the roadways. In New Jersey traffic lights are like starting lines for drag races. Merging is a competitive sport. And also some people break the law: running lights, not signaling, not yielding, being discourteous and driving while impaired, alcohol or drugs. Marijuana is legal but studies show that the effects on driving (reaction times, reflexes, etc.) are more prolonged with marijuana than with alcohol. Both are bad.

I want to mention that the corner of Remsen Avenue and Sandford Street has been the scene of more than half a dozen accidents. One car drove into the box that controls the traffic light in that intersection, damaging a car and the light pole in the process. A car rolled over on its side one evening on Remsen just in front of the Sacred Heart garden. The driver miraculously got out and ran away. A truck swerved and hit a parked car and drove off. The car was owned by a young man, his first car, which he was to use when he went off to College. And just this week as I'm writing this a brand new BMW ran the red light at the intersection and broke through the the gate at the corner. Luckily it stopped before it hit the statue of the Sacred Heart which is dedicated to our parishioners who died in WWII, their names are inscribed in the base. Please keep them in your prayers. Drive carefully. Try not to be "the other guy."

Una de las lecturas para la vigilia de Pentecostés, tomada del undécimo capítulo del Génesis, narra cómo las personas quisieron construir una torre para alcanzar el cielo y desafiar a Dios. Se conoce como la Torre de Babel. Al final, cada persona termina hablando un idioma diferente y se separan, quedando alienadas unos a otros. Con el descenso del Espíritu Santo en la fiesta de Pentecostés, ocurre lo opuesto: personas que hablan distintos idiomas logran entender a los Apóstoles, cada una en su propia lengua. Es, en verdad, un don de entendimiento. El rey inglés Carlos, en su reciente visita, citó a Oscar Wilde: «Hoy en día tenemos realmente todo en común con Estados Unidos, excepto, por supuesto, el idioma». Como los de Argentina.

En la sociedad actual, resulta cada vez más difícil comunicarse en ocasiones, especialmente en el mismo idioma: el idioma de la civilidad; el ser amables los unos con los otros y ayudarnos mutuamente. Un gran ejemplo de esto en nuestro magnífico estado son las carreteras. En New Jersey, los semáforos parecen líneas de salida para carreras de aceleración. Incorporarse al tráfico se ha convertido en un deporte competitivo. Además, algunas personas infringen la ley: se llevan la luz roja, no usan las señales al doblar, no ceden el paso, actúan con descortesía y conducen bajo los efectos de sustancias, ya sean alcohol o drogas. La marihuana es legal, pero los estudios demuestran que sus efectos en la conducción (tiempos de reacción, reflejos, etc.) son más prolongados que los del alcohol. Ambas sustancias son malas.

Quisiera mencionar que la esquina de Remsen Avenue y Sandford Street ha sido escenario de más de media docena de accidentes. Un automóvil chocó contra la caja de control del semáforo en esa intersección, dañando en el proceso tanto a otro vehículo y al poste de electricidad y la cerca del parqueo. Una tarde, un automóvil volcó y quedó de costado en Remsen Avenue, justo frente al jardín del Sagrado Corazón. El conductor salió milagrosamente y se dio a la fuga. Un camión al doblar, chocó contra un carro estacionado y se dio a la fuga. El automóvil pertenecía a un joven; era su primer carro, lo iba a usar en la universidad. Y precisamente esta misma semana, mientras escribo estas líneas, un BMW nuevo se llevó la luz roja y derribó el portón del jardín de la iglesia en la esquina. Afortunadamente, se detuvo antes de impactar contra la estatua del Sagrado Corazón, la cual está dedicada a nuestros feligreses que fallecieron en la Segunda Guerra Mundial; sus nombres están inscritos en la base. Por favor, ténganlos presentes en sus oraciones. Conduzcan con cuidado. Procuren no ser "el otro tipo."

Flexible Adjustments

April showers bring May flowers, but this year the April showers seem to have gotten off schedule. We had an unusual dry April, and only now are the April showers showing up. The May flowers don't seem to be troubled by the delay, but it has proved to be rather discombobulating for us humans. Not only is the rain off schedule, but the temperature keeps going up and down like an elevator, causing numerous deliberations: do we turn the heating off, or turn it back on? Do we put away the thermal underwear, or bring it back out? Do we shift to summer clothing, or keep warmer clothes? Michael Casey, the Australian Trappist, compared the spiritual life to surfing: you need to keep making minute adjustments every second in order to keep your balance and not tumble overboard. I have never surf-boarded – and I certainly can't do it now in my monastery – but I know exactly what he means. God's grace comes to me new at each moment because situations change at each moment. I need to be alert and balanced to respond to his graces, and I need to pull myself back up and continue my balancing act every time

Ajustes Flexibles

Las lluvias de abril traen las flores de mayo, pero este año las lluvias de abril parecen haberse desfasado. Tuvimos un abril inusualmente seco, y solo ahora están apareciendo las lluvias propias de ese mes. A las flores de mayo no parece inquietarles la demora, pero para nosotros, los humanos, ha resultado ser bastante desconcertante. No solo la lluvia está fuera de su horario habitual, sino que la temperatura sube y baja como un ascensor, suscitando numerosas deliberaciones: ¿apagamos la calefacción o la volvemos a encender? ¿Guardamos la ropa térmica o la sacamos de nuevo? ¿Cambiamos a la ropa de verano o seguimos usando prendas de abrigo? Michael Casey, el monje trapense australiano, comparó la vida espiritual con el surf: es necesario realizar ajustes minúsculos a cada segundo para mantener el equilibrio y no caerse por la borda. Nunca he practicado el surf —y ciertamente no puedo hacerlo ahora en mi monasterio—, pero sé exactamente a qué se refiere. La gracia de Dios llega a mí renovada en cada instante, pues las situaciones cambian a cada momento. Necesito mantenerme alerta y equilibrado para responder a sus gracias, y necesito volver a incorporarme y proseguir con mi ejercicio de equilibrio una y otra vez.

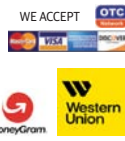

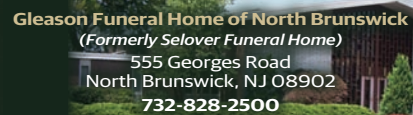
