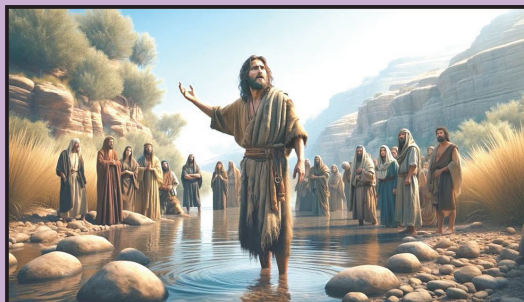

ADVENT.....PEACE

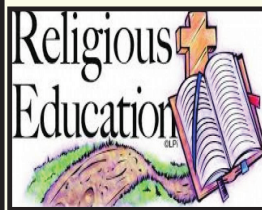

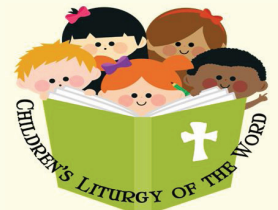

Voice of John Christmas Card Fund Raiser.

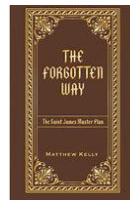
