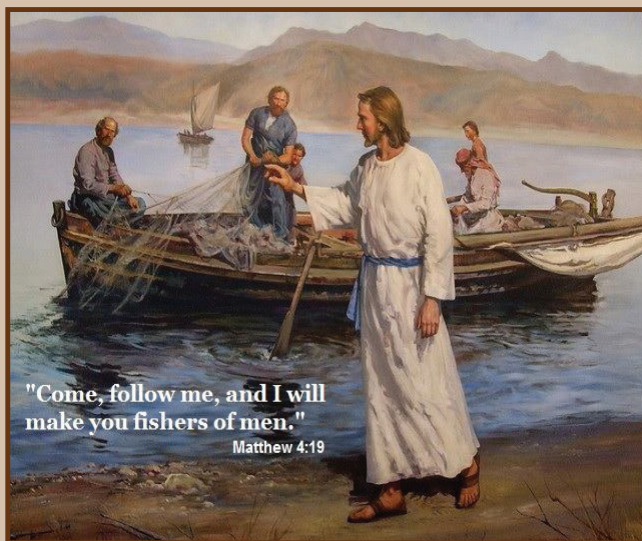

Bible Study

As we shared in recent weeks, our parish will begin a weekly bible study for young adults of high school age and an additional study group for college students and adults. We are pleased to share that these bible studies will begin in earnest in February. The dates and times of these group studies conducted by Fr. Clarke follow (room assignments will be announced soon):

High School Group

(all students in grades 9-12)
each Wednesday from 7pm-8pm

Adult Group

(all people college aged and up)
each Thursday from 7pm –8pm

Here are some suggestions to prepare:

- * If you do not already have a Catholic Bible, purchase one. Why a “Catholic” Bible? Remember, our Bible has additional books not included in other publications. Other Bibles have omitted seven books of the Old Testament; so be sure that your Bible has the 7 books that are not included in other publications. Purchase a Bible that has text that is large enough for you to read and one that you can “cuddle up” with everyday. Make it your own.
- * Our approach will be to study the Sunday readings of the “previous” Sunday. A good way to prepare is to listen attentively to the Word of God on Sunday and to continue to pray over those readings as you prepare to delve in more deeply each week.
- * Our first session will be an overview of the Bible as a whole and offer a reflection on the meaning of the Word of God in our Church and in our daily lives.

We encourage each of you to make a resolution this year to join us for this time of prayer and study. As the great St. Jerome once remarked “ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ”. To study our Sacred Scriptures is not simply to grow in knowledge of revelation and the greatest corpus of literature known to humanity, it is to encounter and to know more personally and more deeply Jesus Christ, Himself. Join us whenever you can. Come any time. No heavy lifting on your part; come; be open; be ready to come to know our Lord revealed to us in His most Holy Word.

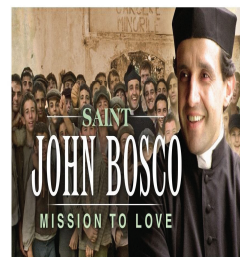
St. Thomas Aquinas | Catholic Saints
