





BISHOP MICHAEL F. BURBIDGE'S STATEMENT ON "HUMAN DIGNITY AND THE THREAT OF A VIRGINIA CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO HUMAN RIGHT TO LIFE": JANUARY 15, 2026

Bishop Burbidge's statement urges us to renew our commitment to protecting every human life from conception to natural death. Marking the Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children (Thursday, January 22), the Bishop calls Catholics to remember the lives lost to abortion, support mothers in need, and stand firmly for the Gospel of Life. He highlights serious concerns during the current General Assembly session, including a proposed constitutional amendment that could enshrine abortion up to birth and possible legislation promoting physician-assisted suicide. Bishop Burbidge invites all Catholics to pray, fast, and advocate with courage and charity, while reaffirming the Church's compassion and healing for those affected by abortion through ministries such as Project Rachel. 




