





Significance of Ashes

The ashes on Ash Wednesday signify repentance, mortality, and mourning for sins, marking the start of Lent as a call to spiritual renewal; they are a biblical symbol of humility and grief, reminding Christians they are "dust to dust" while also representing devotion to Christ as they prepare for Easter. The ashes, made from last year's Palm Sunday palms, are placed on the forehead in the shape of a cross, accompanied by phrases like "Repent and believe in the Gospel" or "Remember you are dust, and to dust you shall return".

Key Meanings of the Ashes:

Repentance: Ashes are an ancient biblical sign of turning away from sin and returning to God.

Mortality: They remind people of their human frailty and eventual death, echoing the words from Genesis,

Morning: The symbolize grief and sorrow for sins committed, acknowledging Christ's sacrifice.

Belonging to Christ: The cross shape signifies devotion and a commitment to following Jesus.

Spiritual Renewal: They launch the 40-day Lenten journey of prayer fasting and almsgiving, preparing for Easter.


